

SWIMMING POOL CHILD ADMISSIONS POLICY

All children under the age of 8 years must be accompanied by a responsible person aged at least 16 years. Whilst in the pool, the responsible person must maintain constant watch over the children for whom they are responsible and be in close contact with those of their children who are weak or non-swimmers. Weak or non-swimmers must wear arm bands or suitable buoyancy aids.

MAIN POOL

Children under the age of 4 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a ONE TO ONE basis. Children aged between 4 to 7 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a maximum TWO TO ONE basis.

TEACHING POOL

No more than three children aged between 4 to 7, or two children under the age of 4 (who are either swimmers or non-swimmers wearing arm bands or suitable buoyancy aids) may be accompanied by a responsible person ages at least 16 or over.
