

COVID-19 CHILDRENS SWIMMING POOL POLICY

All children under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible person aged at least 18 years. Whilst in the pool, the responsible person must maintain constant watch over the juniors for whom they are responsible and be in close contact with those of their children who are weak or non-swimmers.

Weak or non-swimmers must wear arm bands or suitable buoyancy aids.

Children under the age of 4 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a **ONE TO ONE** basis.

Children aged between 4 to 7 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a Maximum **TWO TO ONE** basis.

No more than three children aged between 4 to 7 or two children under the age of 4 who are either swimmers or non-swimmers wearing arm bands or suitable buoyancy aids may be accompanied by a responsible person aged at least 18 or over
