

Swimming Pool Child Admission Policy

All children under the age of 8 years must be accompanied by a responsible person aged at least 16 years. Whilst in the pool, the responsible person must maintain constant supervision over the children for whom they are responsible for and be in close contact with those children who are weak or non-swimmers.

Weak or non-swimmers must wear arm bands or suitable buoyancy aids.

Children under the age of 4 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a **ONE TO ONE** basis.

Children aged between 4 to 7 must be accompanied by a responsible person on a maximum **TWO children TO ONE Adult** basis.

CHILDREN'S USE OF CHANGING ROOMS

No child above the age of 8 years is permitted into a changing room for the opposite sex, unless there are special circumstances, in which case permission must be obtained from the Centre Management.
